

# The Container

## Customer Journey Model

Decide the experience. Map the journey. Name the access point. Lock the container.

SESSION ARC · 90 MINUTES

### 01

#### Opening Frame 5-10

Bridge review — participants share the one move they made after Session 4 and what it produced. What did the move reveal about your lane and your client? Grounds the room in real data before the container design work begins.

### 02

#### Teaching 15-20 min

The Container framework delivered via presentation. The four journey archetypes, the five touchpoints from discovery to yes, the access point decision, and the four alignment tests every container must pass before it is ready to run.

### 03

#### Silent Work 15-20 m

Complete the Session Worksheet independently. Archetype selection with the reasoning, five touchpoint journey map, access point named specifically, four alignment tests run, and the container decision committed to in writing. This is your build brief.

### 04

#### Hot Seats 20-25 min

Two participants map and commit to their container live with the coach. The friction surfaces here — confusion about the access point, a journey that serves the practitioner instead of the client, a test that does not pass. The group observes and learns from every correction made.

### 05

#### Commitment 5-10 min

Each participant reads their journey sequence and access point aloud. Complete Post-Session Commitment form today. 72-Hour Bridge begins now — one real move toward your container before Session 6. Research, test, or draft. Not strategy. Action.

#### SESSION FOCUS

#### Deciding, not building

You already know who you are, how you show up, who you serve, and which lane you are in. Session 5 is not a new decision. It is the design question: what does the path look like for the right person to say yes?
